The Wave

There is phenomena that takes place at many sporting events; it's called, "The Wave". It starts when a group of people rise to their feet, fling their hands in the air and sit back down with the hope that people to the right of them will do the same motion and then the people after them until it makes a trip all around a stadium.

Two thousand years ago (give or take a decade or two) another group of people gathered to create a wave. This time it was not for a sporting event but for the arrival of one humble man, upon a humble donkey, for whom the people hoped would be the promised deliverer of Israel. Not satisfied with just waving their arms in celebration, they gave a victor's welcome by waving palm branches and laying cloaks upon the ground for this kingly one to tread upon. It was quite the scene. Had Twitter been invented this would have been a "trending event."

For millennia the church has celebrated this triumphal entry on a day we call Palm Sunday. This is the day we remember when Jesus, the Messiah, rode into the city of Jerusalem. Tragically, this week would find him not crowned with a king's crown, but with a crown of thorns. Rather than continuing to celebrate his arrival, many in these same crowds will end the week with shouts of "crucify!"

As we celebrate this Holy Week, where do you find yourself amongst the groups that gathered? Will you remain steadfast in declaring Jesus King of kings, or will you slip away into the shadows as his popularity begins to wane? Will you lift your arms in praise or remain like some of the jeering crowd?

My prayer is that you will join the gathered church and proclaim, "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the Name of the LORD!"
