Where do you find your rest?

This was the topic for the sermon we heard on Sunday in Chicago. This church is one that I have considered my home church since college. It was a well timed sermon for me to hear. They had a guest speaker come in and preach. He is planting a church in Knoxville, Tennessee. The church will be called "Hope Church," and their mission is, "We live to help people find rest, find hope, and find purpose in the Gospel of Jesus Christ."

So, where do you find your rest? Is it in TV, Social Media, Sleep, Vacation, shutting off the world for a day?

Charley, the guest preacher from Alpine Chapel, read to us Matthew 11:28-30, "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

When was the last time you found rest in Jesus? I know for me, before this weekend it had been longer than I want to admit. It was no wonder my stress levels were so high that one thing could trigger me and my anxiety would go through the roof. I was on edge and angry at the world. I found rest in this world and not rest in Jesus. I let stress overtake my life and instead of taking Jesus' yoke, I grabbed a rope and tried to plow through my problems alone.

Where do you find your rest? The yoke of Christ will always be more restful than anything this world can offer. Let us fix our eyes on Him, so that we do not grow weary!
