QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION AND DISCUSSION

Read the following Scriptures from Sunday's message. What strikes you as challenging, convicting, or encouraging?

 James 4:1-12
 I John 3:11-12
 Jeremiah 3:20
 Hosea 1-3

 Matthew 7:1-5
 Acts 3:19
 2 Chronicles 7:14-15

The real problem <u>between</u> us is the war raging <u>within</u> us. [James 4:1-4]

- As you think about your relationships and accept that the problem isn't just "out there" but "in here", what wars are raging inside of you, and why?
- What frustrated or wrongly motivated desires are causing brokenness in your life and relationships?

• In what ways do you need to repair those relationships through humble confession and repentance?

Submit yourself to God, who gives greater grace to the humble. [James 4:5-12]

- God's grace is greater than our sin of murderous thoughts, adulterous false worship and breaking His law of love. Where do you need to humble yourself, submit to God, be cleansed, mourn, and experience His grace to lift you back up?
- How encouraging is it to you that the God of the universe yearns jealously for you to wholly be in faithful relationship with Him? How is God's "jealously" different from sinful human jealousy?
- What is the connection between sorrowful repentance in God's people and spiritual revival? (Acts 3:19; 2 Chronicles 7:14-15)
- What might happen if we as a church family develop a deep sense of sorrow over our own sin and humble ourselves in repentance? How might that impact us? The world around us?
