What influences or voices in your world model pride, harsh anger, impatience, or bitterness instead of humility, gentleness, patience, and forbearing love?

How does the example and finished work of Jesus Christ lead us in a better way?

What is the Spirit of God specifically leading you to turn from in repentance so that you can walk unhindered in diligently keeping Gospel unity in the church?
