Read [Revelation 2:1-7](#). In what ways have we [and you personally] abandoned or forsaken our first love [Jesus] for other loves? How has this damaged our witness for Christ?

Read [Matthew 28:16-20](#); [Acts 1:6-11](#). Why are we still here on earth? What is our source of power [ability] to engage in the mission Jesus has entrusted to us?

Read [Matthew 22:34-40](#); [John 13:34-35](#) [also [Col 3:12-14](#)]; [Luke 6:27-36](#). What does Jesus teach us about the necessity of **displaying** the Gospel by loving all people?

Read [Romans 10:1-17](#); [Peter 2:1-10](#); [3:8-18](#). What do these Scriptures teach us about the necessity of **declaring** the Gospel by giving testimony with our words?

Pastor Steve listed some common “obstacles” that can keep us from giving testimony of the Gospel with our words. Which ones are obstacles to you?

RESPOND:

You can't **GO** with Jesus on mission if you don't **KNOW** Him as Savior and Lord. Do you know Him? Will you repent of your sins and put your faith in Jesus alone for your forgiveness and salvation? Reach out to Pastor Steve or another believer to help you with this.
